The survey of all the businesses on North Lombard, between N. Woolsley and the cut is complete. 68 businesses exist on this stretch of Lombard and each was contacted at least once. (2) were not open, (2) had no opinion, (3) did not have an office or owner on site, (3) have not responded to printed material left at the business, and (4) were skipped. Of the non-responders, Tanya Scott has taken on the assignment of trying to make contact.

Those responding voted (7) Lombard District and (47) University Park. Of the 21 non-responders, it is unlikely that they would not change the outcome of University Park being the overwhelming favorite of business owners / operators.

As chairpersons for the NPBA Community Outreach and Communications committees, Tanya and I see our ongoing role in this effort largely as staying in touch with this group as it moves toward securing funding for any next steps. We would like be included in the distribution of any meeting notes.
